General Rules Covering the L.V. Orton Memorial Award:

1. The applicant must have completed his senior year of high school by the start of the Annual Conclave.
2. Only one application will be accepted from each Chapter. The applicant must be an active member in good standing at the time of application.
3. Each application must be signed by the Chapter Advisor.
4. Each application is to be received by date selected each year to be considered. Applications should be e-mailed to the State Advisors Association, in care of: Oklahoma DeMolay Association, EO@okdemolay.com.
5. Each applicant must attend Conclave and meet with the selection committee after lunch on Saturday.
6. A DeMolay may win only one scholarship; however, an applicant may submit an application more than once.
7. The winner will receive a scholarship to the school of his choice. This scholarship may be used only for tuition and books. If the balance is not used during the first year, the remainder may be used the second year until the total amount is used.

8. The selection of the screening committee is final. This committee will be composed of Master Masons and will be selected from year to year by the Executive Officer.

The L.V. Orton Award is presented annually to an Oklahoma DeMolay for outstanding achievement in five areas: Education, Self-Expression, Activities outside of the Order of DeMolay, Religious Life, and DeMolay activities. Each Chapter within the Jurisdiction of Oklahoma is allowed to place in nomination the name of one of its Chapter members for consideration for this recognition and award. This application blank should be filled out (either by the nominee or by his Chapter Advisor) and returned to the Executive Officer by date selected. In addition to this application form, the 10 finalists will be interviewed by a selection committee during the Annual State Conclave. Presentation of the award will be made at the awards banquet which concludes each Annual State Conclave.
